To provide our beneficiaries with a secure environment for their healthcare information, TriWest established a standard of confidentiality for information about a range of medical diagnoses that can be considered sensitive. Information that is deemed to be “sensitive health information” is anything related to the treatment of:

- Reproductive health
- Substance abuse
- HIV
- Rape
- Sexually transmitted diseases
- Mental health
- Abuse

To protect beneficiary privacy, “sensitive health information” is not available on [www.triwest.com](http://www.triwest.com) and is only available in writing or by calling 1-888-TRIWEST. Additionally, beneficiaries with a secure TriWest.com account will only receive QuickAlert emails for non-sensitive auths and referrals.

The list below provides the specific diagnoses that TriWest defines as “sensitive health information”.
